

Day 1
Parable of the Sower and the Seed
Luke 8:4-15

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1) Why is it exciting to know that Jesus wants to give us His seed (His truth, His word)?

{It is exciting because then we know God is giving his plan for our lives. His plan tells us why he made us and tells us how we should live, how to live in our families, how to treat our friends and, most of all, how to be friends of God.}

2) Why does Jesus want His seed (His truth, His word) to grow in our hearts?

{Jesus has a plan for our lives. Jesus has died for us so we can be friends with God without our sins blocking our path to God. Jesus wants us to know all about his plan.}

3) What can we do to get ready or prepare our hearts for Jesus' words to grow in our lives?

{suggested things we can do may be reading the Bible, memorizing Bible verses, singing songs about Jesus, going to church and Sunday School (if possible, in the future), others?}

MEMORY VERSE

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalm 119:105

Day 2
Jesus Walks on Water
Matthew 14:22-36

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1) When we have hard days how can we be sure Jesus is there to help us?

{We know what is true about God from the Bible. We can be certain that Jesus loves us; He is not far away; He will listen to our prayers and He is more powerful than anything in the universe}

2) Why is it hard to keep our eyes on Jesus when we are in the middle of trouble?

{We can't see Jesus with our eyes but we can see our trouble. It can be a test to trust what the Bible says about Jesus and His love and His power but it is the truth.}

3) How can we learn to look at Jesus instead of the trouble around us?

{We can learn to have Jesus as our closest friend, the person we talk to everyday, the person we tell everything. We can learn more about God by reading the Bible, listening to Bible stories and singing songs about Jesus}

MEMORY VERSE

Day 3
Jesus Calls His Disciples
Luke 5:1-11

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1) When you and your friends are choosing teams on the playground, why does it feel good to hear your name called?

{Everyone needs to feel important. It makes us feel good. God knows everyone's name; He knows everything about us and loves us. He is calling everyone to be his follower and friend}

2) How does it feel to know that Jesus is calling you to be on His team, to be His disciple?

{God is the most important person in the universe. If He knows my name and if He wants to be my friend, if He is calling me to be on His team, to be His follower then I have a very important job to do.}

3) What kinds of things does Jesus ask you to do as part of being his follower?

{Pray, read God's word, to love and serve God, to love and serve others, to follow what God says we should do like obey our parents.}

Day 4
Saul on the Road to Damascus

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1) What did God want Saul to understand about Jesus?

{He wanted Saul to know that Jesus is the promised Messiah, the one God the Father sent down to earth to die for everyone's sin.}

2) Why did God want Saul to know this about Jesus?

{He wanted Saul to know because it is the most important thing anyone can know about God and His plan to save everyone from their sins. It is God's way to change us so we can be His friend. He wanted Saul to travel around the world to tell everyone about God's plan and the fantastic work Jesus did when He died and rose again.}

3) What have you learned this week about God and his plan for you?
